Withdrawal Policy: if at anytime, a student wishes to withdraw from gifted services, the request form can be obtained from school website, district office, or school office. Written withdrawal form from the parent needs to be sent to gifted coordinator, **Sandra Plantz, Gallia County Local Schools, 4836 St. Rt. 325, Patriot, OH 45658**. A copy will be sent to the school child is enrolled for file. If a child and parent wish for return to services, parents must complete a written request and referral form, then send it to gifted coordinator by May to be considered for the following year. Student will be considered again, but along with all of the other new referrals, so return placement is not automatic.
